

Librarian Report September 2018

We have given out 60 new library cards in 2018 as of the end of August. That's 1 less than all of 2017. Increasing this number was one of my priorities this year and it has so far been an impressive year for new members.

Due to lack of room for the 8'x4' heavy table required for First Lego League the team will be moving the table to a room in the NEKLS building. The game requires a large amount of fragile lego and we have no room for a table of that size. I signed a temporary use agreement with the ENSU to use the room until December and the end of the season.

The window restoration specialist Sally Fishburn informed me she would come to replace some windows but later told me she could not make it. She hopes to come up this week and swap out the next set.
